1 June 2026 – ARRIVAL DAY

Arrivals at Tivat, Podgorica, Dubrovnik, or Tirana airports

- Private transfers to Hyatt Regency Kotor

The Boka Bay

Boka Bay, the southernmost fjord in Europe is without doubt one of the most beautiful fjords in the world. The high mountains that bend around the coastline protect the bay from the open sea and from the cold climate of the north in winter. The Bay is naturally divided into four smaller parts – Herceg Novi, Risan, Kotor and Tivat, and each of these well-preserved medieval towns is a story for itself.



FIRST STOP – Kotor Old Town, the UNESCO protected heritage site

Start from your hotel by boat and cruise towards Kotor Bay and explore the medieval Old Town of KOTOR.

The Old Town Kotor is on the list of UNESCO of the world cultural inheritance, and its walls hide many significant monuments like: Clock Tower, Cathedral of Sveti Tripun, Church of Sveti Luka, Napoleon's theater from the XIX century, etc.

Different periods and cultures have left the clear mark in architectural mixture and atmosphere of the town. The tour is taking you to a brief, yet memorable journey through the history of the Old Town of Kotor.

With every step you make, Kotor Old Town will take you back in time, to feel the spirit of Illyrian, Roman, Gothic, renaissance or baroque culture...



Visit to the Island Our Lady of the Rocks – The Jewel of Boka Bay



Our Lady of the Rocks

Legend has it that Our Lady of the Rocks, was in fact formed after sailors from Perast found a picture of the Virgin Mary on the rock. They took an oath that after every successful voyage they would lay a rock in this very spot so that a church could be built on top of these rocks. This tradition continued down the centuries and eventually this is how the islet was formed. Today, the islet with its Beautiful Baroque church is a unique venue hiding many interesting stories and secrets.

Continue towards Perast for a short walk through this fairytale towny and enjoy lunch overlooking the Islands.

Perast

One of the hidden jewels of Boka Bay is charming baroque town of Perast. Rich in Venice-like architecture with marvelous palaces, numerous Catholic churches, series of defensive towers, all set in stone seem like time has stood still.



Lunch at restaurant CONTE, Perast



Restaurant “Conte” is located in the beautiful baroque town of Perast, offering breathtaking views of the Bay of Kotor. Its authentic interior blends wood and stone with charming vintage details, creating a timeless atmosphere. The stunning terrace on the pier is the perfect place to enjoy an exquisite selection of seafood and traditional Montenegrin dishes.

Kotor Cable Car experience

The journey continues to the iconic Lovćen Mausoleum, majestically positioned atop Mount Lovćen. From this extraordinary vantage point, take in sweeping views that stretch from the mountains to the sea, a moment that perfectly captures the spirit of Montenegro.



Cetinje – Old Royal capital of Montenegro

Next, explore the historic Old Royal Capital of Cetinje, a town rich in royal heritage, culture, and quiet elegance, where Montenegro's past reveals itself through grand architecture and timeless stories.



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On the return, travel along the legendary **Serpentine Road**, where each curve reveals ever more dramatic vistas over the Boka Bay, offering some of the most photographed views in the country.

Conclude the day at **Storia di Pietra Winery**, where refined wine tasting is paired with a carefully curated dinner.
